Applying to the Rental Allowance Program known as RAP?

The RAP Program is a monthly rental allowance that pays money towards your rent for up to 12 months if you are homeless or have limited household income with critical housing needs. You can apply at:

DID YOU KNOW....

You may qualify for the Renter's Tax Credit?

The Renter's Tax Credit is a Program that offers a tax credit for individuals who rent.. If you qualify you can received up to \$750 each year.

Eligibility:

- Eligible residents are low-income families who are homeless, in danger of becoming homeless, or in need of emergency housing. Incomes of assisted households cannot exceed 30 percent of the statewide or area median income, whichever is higher.
- $\diamond\,$ You must be 60 years or older or 100% disabled
- ◊ Be a surviving spouse of someone that was 60 years or older or 100% disabled
- OR under 60 years old, have one or more children under 18 that lives in your household, you do not received federal or state housing subsidies and you have income below a certain limit.

How to apply:

You can apply for the Renter's Tax Credit by downloading an application; calling the Renter's Tax Credit Program to have an application mailed to you; or you can go to the local office at:

If any of these resources are out of funds, continue calling every 1 - 2 days. If possible, fill out an application, so you will be first on the list when money comes in. You may be expected to make a financial contribution for help; however, some locations provide waivers, so don't skip your appointment.

IMPORTANT: If you are late on the rent and you get a court notice, <u>always</u> go to court. This will help you when seeking financial assistance, legal assistance, and/or a "stay" to prevent eviction, if needed.
