**REQUEST TO RETURN EMERGENCY MOTION FOR RELIEF FROM RISK OF
INJURY AND DEATH FROM COVID-19 TO THE ACTIVE DOCKET, AND
RENEWED REQUEST FOR EXPEDITED CONSIDERATION,
WITH PARTIALLY UNOPPOSED REQUEST FOR SHORTENED TIME TO RESPOND**

Counsel for the Plaintiff Class filed an Emergency Motion for Relief from Risk of Injury and Death from COVID-19 (Doc. No. 645) on April 9, 2020. The parties engaged in a 2-hour emergency mediation session with the Hon. Timothy Sullivan, United States Magistrate Judge, on April 10. The same day, with the parties’ consent, this Court issued an order (Doc. No. 647) holding the motion in abeyance and directing the parties to notify chambers if a briefing schedule is needed.

On Friday, May 15, 2020, Class Counsel notified counsel for Defendants and Judge Sullivan of their intention to file a supplement to the pending emergency motion for expedited consideration by the Court. Judge Sullivan again arranged an emergency mediation, which took place for over an hour on Monday, May 18.

Counsel for the parties, with much appreciated assistance from Judge Sullivan, have made and will continue to make every effort to resolve this matter by agreement. However, matters beyond the parties’ control, as set forth in the supplement to the emergency motion filed herewith, prevent an adequate solution that safeguards the lives of class members without relief from this
